

# Marketscope Trading From Charts Userguide

New Chart Stuff: **Trading from charts!**

You can now trade straight from the charts in the FX Trading Station. To make an order, point to the level that you want to buy or sell at, and right click:



Choose Create Entry Order. A confirmation screen will appear.



Click OK, and your order is entered into the system. The chart shows the price of your order with a line.



OR

You can left click anywhere on the price list on the far right of the screen, and an Entry Order confirmation screen appears.

You can adjust Stop and Limit orders that are attached to Entry Orders by right-clicking on the label for the Entry Order, then choosing “Add Stop Order”, “Add Limit Order”, or “Remove Entry Order”.



You can now track your trades visually on the charts!

You can also view your Stop and Limit orders on your chart, as well as the price you entered the trade at.

Here is an example of a trade in your Open Positions window:

On the chart, you can see all the orders, with the Open Price, Stop, and Limit shown as separate, differently colored lines.

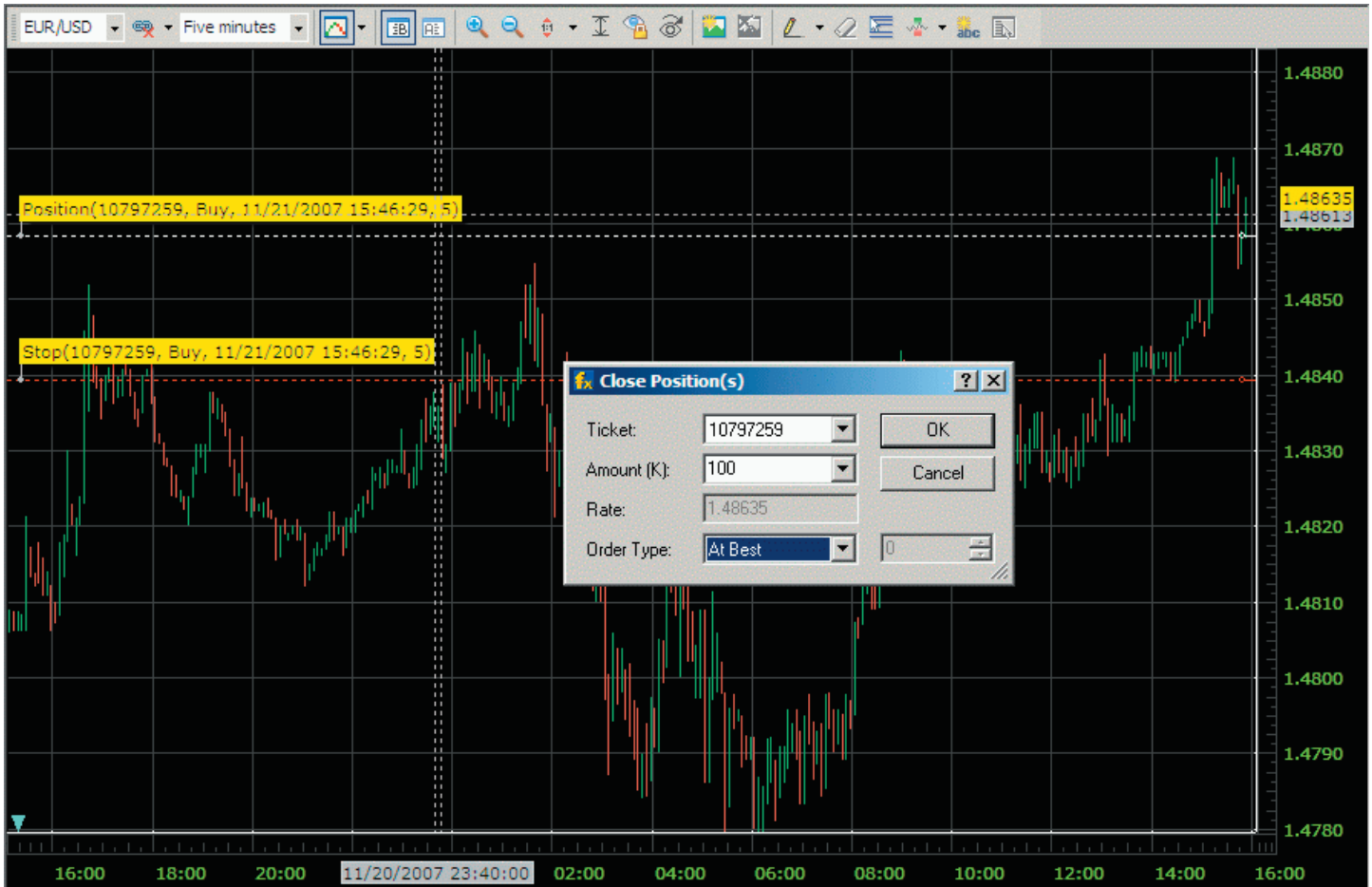


You can also change the level of your stop right from the charts. Simply left-click on the stop line, hold down your left mouse button, and drag the stop line to where you want it. A confirmation box will appear with the new level.



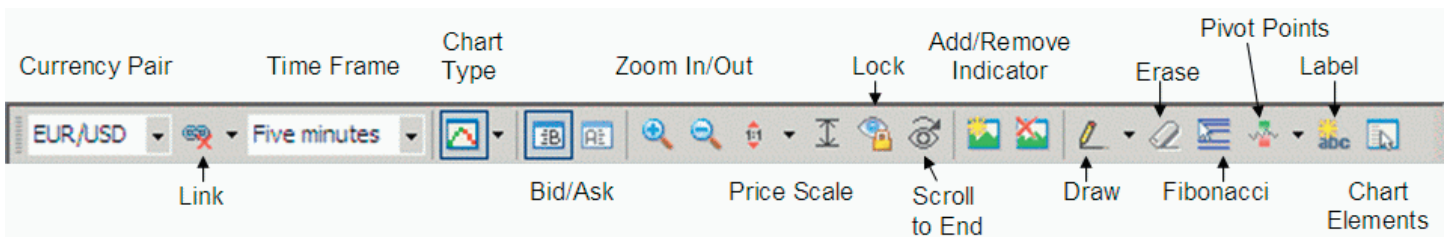
You can change the level of your Limit Order in exactly the same way.

You can close your trade at the current price right from the chart, too. Simply left-click on the label to indicate where you started the trade, and you'll get a confirmation window.



## New Functions:

We've also added some new buttons to the charts toolbar.



Items marked with a \* are new.

- **Currency Pair:** You can change the pair here.
- **Link\*:** Allows you to link several charts together.
- **Time Frame:** Change the time frame.
- **Chart Type:** Choose Candlestick, Bar, or Line charts.
- **Bid/Ask\*:** You can have the chart show you only the Sell Price (Bid), or the Buy Price (Ask).
- **Zoom In/Out:** Change the Zoom level.



- **Price Scale\***: Snap the charts to fit your screen size perfectly.
- **Lock\***: Toggles on and off the ability to move the charts around.
- **Scroll to End\***: takes you immediately to the right edge of the chart.
- **Add/Remove Indicator**: Choose from over 30 technical indicators.
- **Draw**: Use this tool to draw Trendlines, Support, and Resistance.
- **Erase**: Erase Lines.
- **Fibonacci**: Draw Fibonacci Retracement lines.
- **Pivot Points\***: Show Pivot Points drawn by the chart program.
- **Label**: Add text labels.
- **Chart Elements**: Add, Remove, or change the parameters of any line or indicator on the chart, using this convenient list.

### Linked Charts:

You can now link different charts together. In the link menu, you can link all your charts, or group them by color.



If you change the currency pair in one chart, all charts linked to it will change to the same currency pair. This is useful when you use multiple time frames for technical analysis, and want to change the pair you are working with.
